Since then, the core idea of creating mismatched yet narrative images has inspired more than 300 designs. Kevin is now also making sculptures and ornaments out of the paper-mache' from the paper clippings left over from making the earrings.

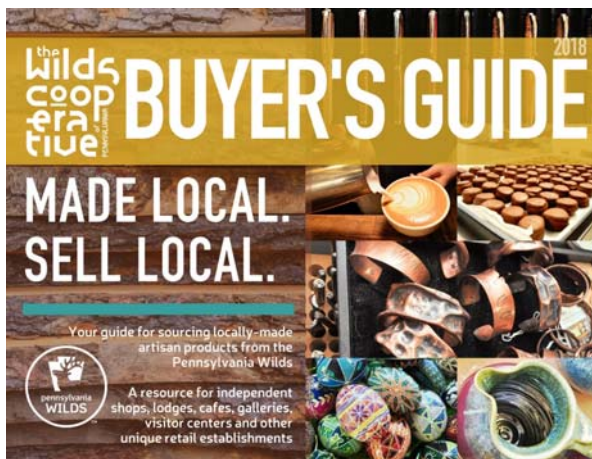
